We have been very busy behind the scenes preparing access for remote learning in the eventuality that school will have to close. We are pleased to say that all the children have managed to log into the classes Google Classroom accounts. We will be sending instructions home early next week to ensure that they are able to access it at home. Please inform us as soon as possible if you have any difficulties. We also have subscriptions to Purple Mash and Espresso that will support home learning. If you have any questions please do ask myself or any of the teachers.

The children have been very mature in their approach to hand washing. We are also spraying door handles on a regular basis throughout the day. We will keep you informed of any changes in the guidance as it happens. If you are a volunteer in school, please can you also wash your hands as you arrive and before you leave. We have anti bac spray in the office.



At this stage the school trip on Tuesday to The Stables for Reception and Key Stage 1 will still go ahead. If this changes we will let you know. We have made the decision to postpone the Arts Evening on Thursday. This is because of the mixed ages and the volume of people we hope would attend. We will set a new date in the summer term.
